■ Grammar Reference

Use 1 — Life experience: Things you have done (or never done) in your life. We don't say exactly when.
I have visited Paris. | *She has never eaten sushi.*

Use 2 — Recent action, present result: Something happened recently and the result is important now.
I have lost my keys. (= *I can't find them now.*)

Type	Example
Positive (I/you/we/they)	I have visited Paris.
Positive (he/she/it)	She has eaten sushi.
Negative	I haven't visited Paris.
Question	Have you ever visited another country?
Short answer	Yes, I have. / No, I haven't.

Verb	Past Participle	Verb	Past Participle
be	been	eat	eaten
see	seen	meet	met
do	done	lose	lost
break	broken	win	won

Regular verbs add -ed: visit → visited, cook → cooked, play → played, watch → watched, try → tried.
