Vocabulary

Rooms in a house

living room (noun)	The main room in a house for relaxing and spending time with family.	<i>"We watch television in the living room every evening."</i>
bedroom (noun)	The room where you sleep. It usually has a bed.	<i>"I have a small bedroom with a big window."</i>
kitchen (noun)	The room where you prepare and cook food.	<i>"I cook dinner in the kitchen every evening."</i>
bathroom (noun)	The room with a bath or shower, a toilet, and a sink.	<i>"I have a shower in the bathroom every morning."</i>
garden (noun)	An area of land outside your home where you can grow plants or sit outside.	<i>"We have a small garden with flowers and a table."</i>
flat (noun)	A home that is part of a larger building; an apartment.	<i>"I live in a small flat on the third floor."</i>
house (noun)	A building where one family lives, usually with a garden.	<i>"They live in a big house near the park."</i>
floor (noun)	The level of a building; also the surface you walk on.	<i>"My flat is on the second floor."</i>

Furniture and objects

sofa (noun)	A large comfortable seat for two or more people in the living room.	<i>"I sit on the sofa and watch television in the evening."</i>
table (noun)	A piece of furniture with a flat top and legs, used for eating or working.	<i>"We eat dinner at the table in the kitchen."</i>
chair (noun)	A seat for one person, with four legs and a back.	<i>"There is one chair at my desk."</i>
bed (noun)	The furniture you sleep on at night.	<i>"I have a big comfortable bed in my bedroom."</i>
wardrobe (noun)	A large cupboard where you keep your clothes.	<i>"My wardrobe is full of clothes."</i>
desk (noun)	A table you use for working or studying, often with drawers.	<i>"I have a desk in my bedroom. I study there every day."</i>

window (noun)	An opening in a wall with glass that lets in light and air.	<i>"My bedroom has a big window. It is very bright."</i>
door (noun)	A flat piece of wood or metal that you open and close to enter or leave a room.	<i>"Please close the door when you leave."</i>

Describing your home

big (adjective)	Large in size; the opposite of small.	<i>"We have a big kitchen with a lot of space."</i>
small (adjective)	Not large; little in size.	<i>"My bedroom is small but comfortable."</i>
comfortable (adjective)	Pleasant and relaxing to use or be in.	<i>"My sofa is very comfortable. I love sitting on it."</i>
clean (adjective)	Free from dirt; not dirty.	<i>"I keep my kitchen very clean."</i>
quiet (adjective)	Without much noise; peaceful.	<i>"My street is very quiet at night."</i>
light (adjective)	Full of natural light from the sun; bright.	<i>"My living room is light because it has a big window."</i>
